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Dear Parents,

Choosing the right primary school for your child is one of the most important decisions you will make as a parent. As a mother myself, I completely understand how significant this choice is, and I want to help you get a true sense of what our school offers to support your decision.

We like to think of ourselves as the "Meir Heath Family." Once you join, you'll never want to leave. Many parents who entrust us with their children were once students here themselves, and they wouldn't choose any other school. Likewise, many of our teachers began their careers here as Newly Qualified Teachers and have never left—some have been part of our school for over 20 years. I began my journey at Meir Heath 14 years ago as Deputy Headteacher and took on the role of Principal 7 years ago after the retirement of my predecessor. Every day, I feel incredibly fortunate to work with such wonderful staff and students—they make this the perfect job for me. We are truly a happy, dedicated, and supportive team.

We're also unique. During our OFSTED inspection in October 2019, the inspector remarked, "There's something magical in the air at Meir Heath." Our core values—*Happy, Hardworking, and Caring*—shine through to everyone who visits us. I believe this magic stems from the love, care, and passion our entire team brings to everything we do. At Meir Heath, we've created what I believe is the perfect recipe for an outstanding education. Our curriculum is ambitious, engaging, and designed to maintain high academic standards, as reflected in our excellent results. We are fortunate to have specialist teachers for PE and music, both of whom are invaluable assets to our team. Their dedication enriches our students' lives through numerous community events, after-school clubs, and an active sporting and musical calendar. We've been honoured with the *Sports Platinum Award* and the *Silver Music Mark* for our efforts.

In addition to our academic success, we have fully embraced the *OPAL (Outdoor Play and Learning)* play initiative, which has completely transformed our lunchtimes. OPAL is a nationally recognised program designed to enhance the quality of children's play by encouraging creative, adventurous, and inclusive outdoor play across the entire school grounds. At Meir Heath, children now have access to a wide range of outdoor activities that engage their imaginations and physical abilities. Whether they are building dens, climbing, or exploring nature, the children absolutely love their time outside. The positive impact on their social skills, well-being, and overall happiness is clear to see. Our play provision has been so successful that we've been commended and even featured in the highlights on the OPAL Schools website—an achievement we are incredibly proud of!

Throughout the year, we plan many events that invite parents to actively participate in their child's learning. From creative workshops and outdoor sessions to our popular "special person lunches" (for EYFS and KS1 parents) and Bee Active workshops, there are many opportunities to be part of your child's school experience. In addition, we host performances such as nativities, plays, and class assemblies. Feedback from parents is consistently positive, and the children love sharing their learning with their families.

Our Early Years Team is truly exceptional, with a wealth of experience and dedication. Mrs. Fisher, our EYFS Leader and Assistant Principal, is a former Meir Heath student herself and has been teaching here for 17 years. She has the biggest heart and embodies our school values in everything she does. The entire team radiates warmth and possesses the essential qualities needed to nurture young children.

We also use *ClassDojo* as our main platform for communication between school and home. ClassDojo is a secure app that allows teachers to share important updates, announcements, and classroom activities directly with parents. It enables you to stay informed about your child's progress and school events in real-time, as well as receive photos, videos, and messages about their learning experiences. One of the key benefits of ClassDojo is that it encourages positive reinforcement, with teachers awarding points for good behavior, effort, and teamwork. This allows you to see and celebrate your child's achievements throughout the day. By using

ClassDojo, we foster strong home-school connections, ensuring you're always informed and engaged in your child's educational journey.

We are proud members of the St. Bart's Multi Academy Trust (SBMAT), which brings many benefits to our school. We joined the trust in 2017 because of its unwavering focus on educational excellence, a vision that aligns with our own values. With 22 academies across Cheshire, Stoke, and Staffordshire, SBMAT provides a wealth of experience and opportunities for collaboration. Our central leadership team offers regular support and challenge, ensuring we continue to grow. The trust also has a teacher training alliance, which has trained hundreds of graduates over the past 12 years, further enriching our teaching and learning.

Additionally, we are part of the *Partners in Excellence* cluster with Blythe Bridge High School, providing valuable opportunities for collaboration, transition, and sporting events.

In 2021, we embarked on an exciting journey to become an *Apple School*. Now, all our students from Year 1 upwards use one-to-one iPads in their lessons. Our teachers receive regular, up-to-date training from Apple Education consultants, and this initiative has transformed our approach to learning, greatly enhancing pupil engagement. While we've embraced technology, we still value traditional methods, ensuring that pen-and-paper skills remain fundamental.
