<p>At Meir Heath Academy, each child starts their reading journey in Reception Early Years Foundation Stage. The children are introduced to a new book each day of the week during story time. Monday's text is topic related, Tuesday's text is a democratic vote, Wednesday's text is a Religious/Cultural story, Thursday's text is linked to British values/ Fables and Friday's text is a democratic vote. <p>The reading journey is continued in Y1 to Y6 by sharing and studying texts linked to Topics (see below). Story time at the end of the day is celebrated throughout the school. These texts are to promote a love of reading. In Y1, each child has the opportunity to vote for their favourite book out of two choices. In each class, every week a child is selected to complete a recommended read activity, where they write about and share one of their favourite stories.</p>
